

Setting Up Automatic Recording (Without IR blaster)

(See reverse for instructions with IR blaster)

1. Power on TV and **note which stream TV is set to view the picture on. (6, 7,13)**
2. Power on VCR (at this point the picture should go fuzzy).
 - a. Using your original TV remote set TV to channel (3 or 4) to view VCR.
 - b. Now set the VCR channel to receive the stream noted in step 1. (Once VCR is set to right stream the picture should be back on the TV.)
 - c. Insert Blank Tape
3. Using the remote HTC has provided, follow these steps to choose the program you wish to automatically record.
 - a. Go to the on-screen guide by pressing the "Guide" button on the HTC remote.
 - b. Now, using the blue arrow keys, highlight the program you wish to record. **NOTE program's START and STOP time.** (You will need this for setting the VCR.)
 - c. Press the "Select" button on the HTC remote; a new window will pop up. Using the "RIGHT" arrow button, highlight "Actions" and press "Select"; a new window will pop up again.
 - d. Now using the "DOWN" arrow button highlight "Schedule Automatic Tune" and press "Select"; a new window will pop up.
 - e. Select desired channel-tuning options
 - One time - Just once
 - Mon-Fri - Tune to channel everyday at this time
 - Once a Week - Tune to channel once a week at this day/time
 - f. Once selected, a green message will appear on the screen saying: "Automatic Schedule is set up for this channel"
 - g. Press the "Exit" button on HTC remote until TV picture is back on.
4. Using VCR remote, make sure the date and time for the VCR is set to the correct date and time.
 - a. In the VCR menu set up automatic recording by:
 - Setting the date to record
 - Setting the time the show starts as noted in step 3-b
 - Setting the time the show stops as noted in step 3-b
 - b. Once recording is done, power off VCR and set TV back to the stream HTC set up to watch TV on as normal (6, 7 13).
 - c. To view recorded program, tune TV to channel (3 or 4) depending on VCR.
